Who are we?

The Patient Forum has been set up for over 11 years and meets every two months in the Tutbury Village Hall, (situated next to the Health Centre). The group has grown from the initial 4 people, managed by the Practice, into an autonomous group of 20+ members. The meetings are also attended by representatives of the Practice and local Pharmacies. This enables meaningful discussions to be held on many aspects of running the Practice and the issues that they and the patients may have. Our aims are to maintain the quality of care and to work with the Practice on moving forward in these challenging times. We also have representation on both the East Staffs District Patient Engagement Group and the East Staffs Clinical Commissioning Group, (ESCCG), Patient Board. This means we can keep all members updated on both NHS and ESCCG decisions / commissioning plans that could have an impact on the Practice and /or its patients. In addition, our members also are involved in a large number of activities within the community and beyond.

In June 2018, the Forum became members of Support Staffordshire, the first Practice Patient Participation Group to do so. Support Staffordshire was established on 12 January 2015 following the historic merger of six Community Voluntary Services partners across Staffordshire. They support all Voluntary, Community and Social Enterprise member organisations in three main ways:

General Data Protection Regulations May 2018

The new regulations came into force for all organisations across the EU as from the 25th May 2018. If people are regularly involved with the work of the Tutbury Practice Patient Forum and associated Health organisations, by regularly receiving correspondence from us, we have to

contact you on how we hold and manage your contact information. Currently, your information is:

- Only known to the elected officers of the Forum.
- Is stored on the computer system held by the Forum Secretary.
- The system is password protected and has a Total Protection System installed.
- On certain occasions you may be contacted via the Secretaries mobile system. This phone is also password protected and has the same Total Protection System installed.
- If anyone wishes their data to be removed this will be done. After this deletion no further correspondence concerning the Forum and associated Health organisations will be sent to that person.
- The person(s), who made the request to be deleted, can ask to be re-entered into the data base. However, in order for this to take place the person(s) have to complete the Consent form and send to the Forum Secretary.
- When contacting the whole membership via a group email this will be done by "blind copy" so that no one can see other contact details.
- If direct email with named contact(s) is received by the officers of the Forum, then it will be assumed that that person(s) have given their consent for any response to be with email details shown.
